RESOLVED, By the Town Board of the Town of Harmony that Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government (LGS-1) issued pursuant to Article 57-A of the Arts and Cultural Affairs law and containing legal minimum retention periods for local government records, is hereby adopted for use by all officer in legal disposing of valueless records listed therein. FUTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with Article 57-A:

(A) Only those records will be disposed of that are described in Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1), after they have met the minimum retention periods descried therein:

(B) Only those record will be disposed of that do not have sufficient administrative, fiscal, legal or historical value to merit retention beyond established legal minimum periods.
