**Highway Superintendents Report:**

- Highway Superintendent Card reported that the winter has been slow with no break downs.
- Last month Superintendent Card discussed issues with afterhours dumping at the transfer station. Fencing, and camera's had been discusses. After looking at pricing of fencing Superintendent Card recommends no fencing be done at this time. It would be costly to do vs how many people are dumping after hours. He has contacted Tim Baron to look at the current no dumping sign and to give a quote on refurbishing it.
- Superintendent Card also spoke on the cost of recyclables of plastic and newspaper. Of the 180 ton of refuse hauled from the Transfer station 13 Ton where recyclables. The cost for recyclables is \$150 per ton. If the recyclables are contaminated with garbage they must go into the regular dumpster. It is possible that the Town could go to just aluminum and tin recycling. Residents could take newspaper and plastic to the landfill.
